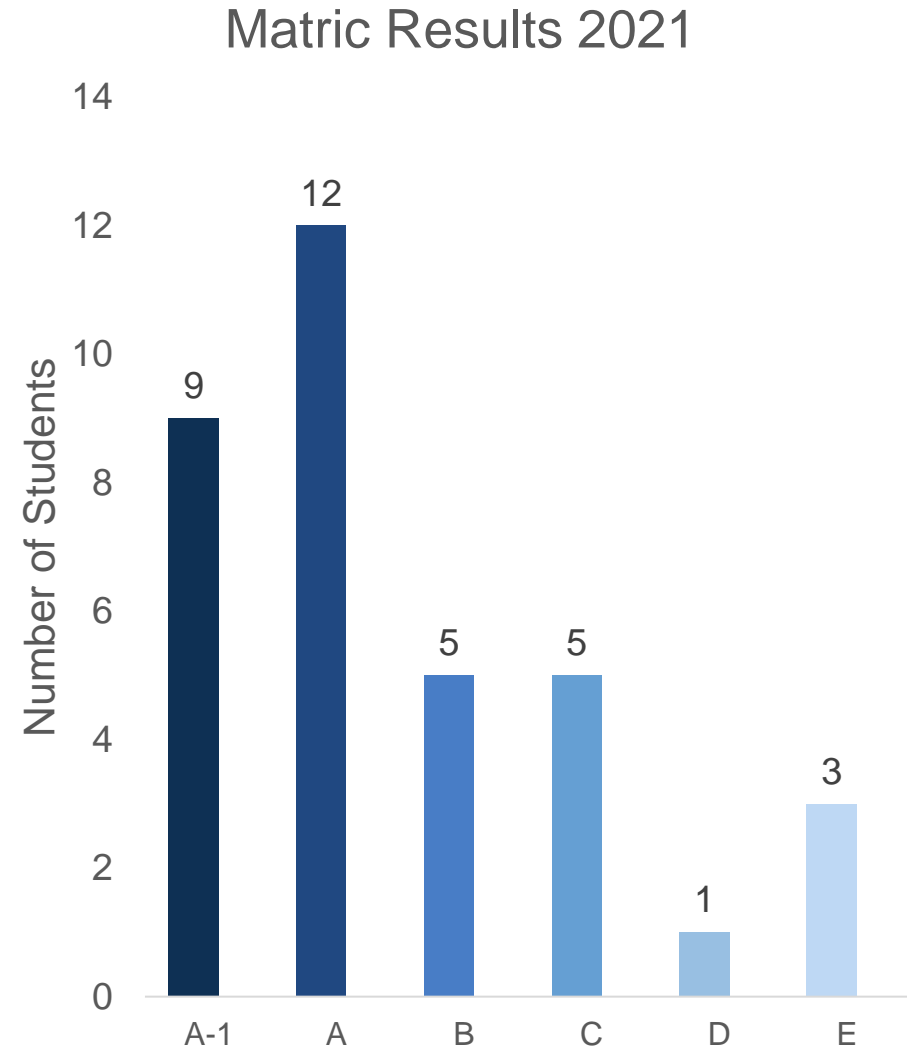

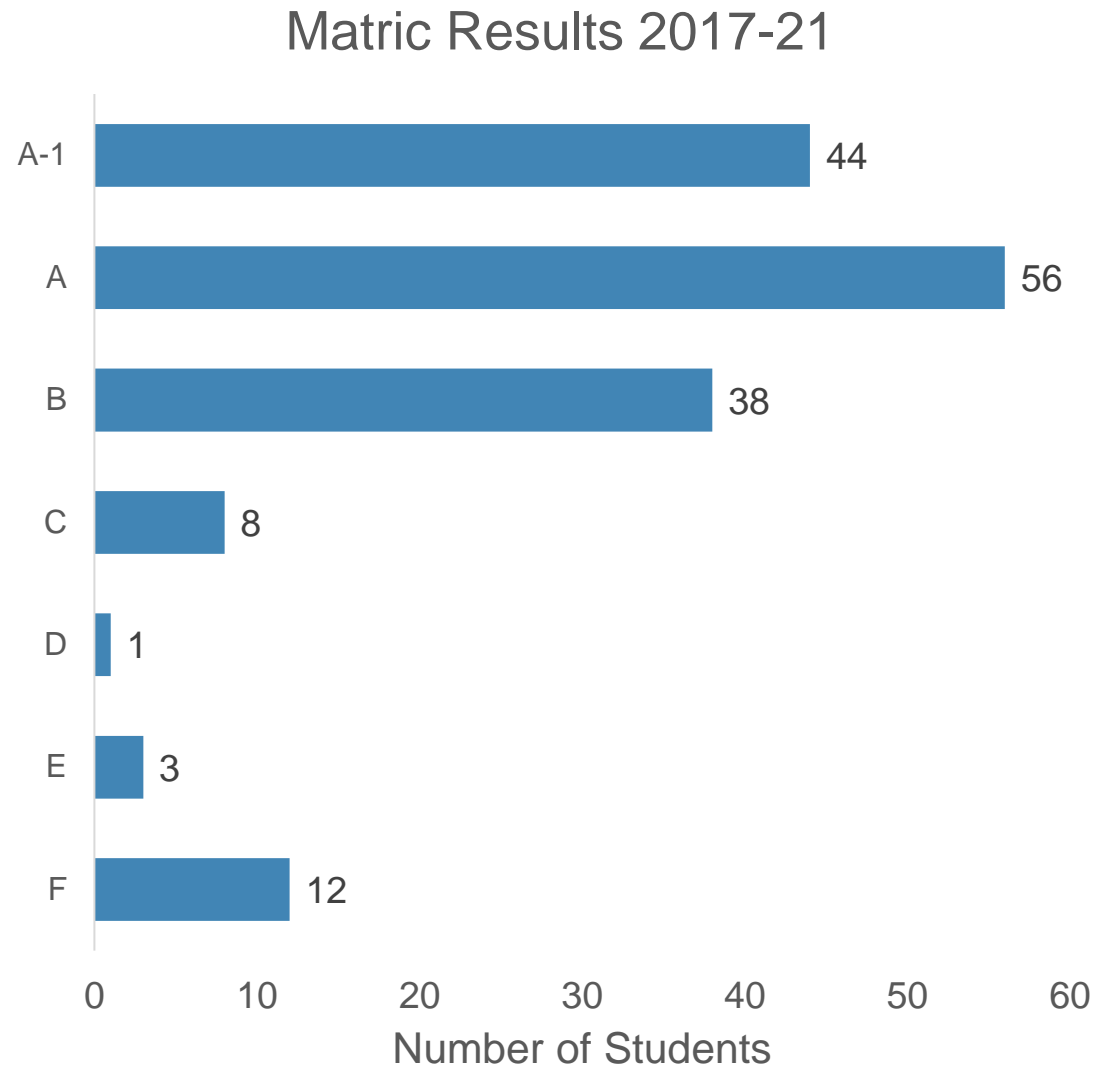

### Actual Subsidy

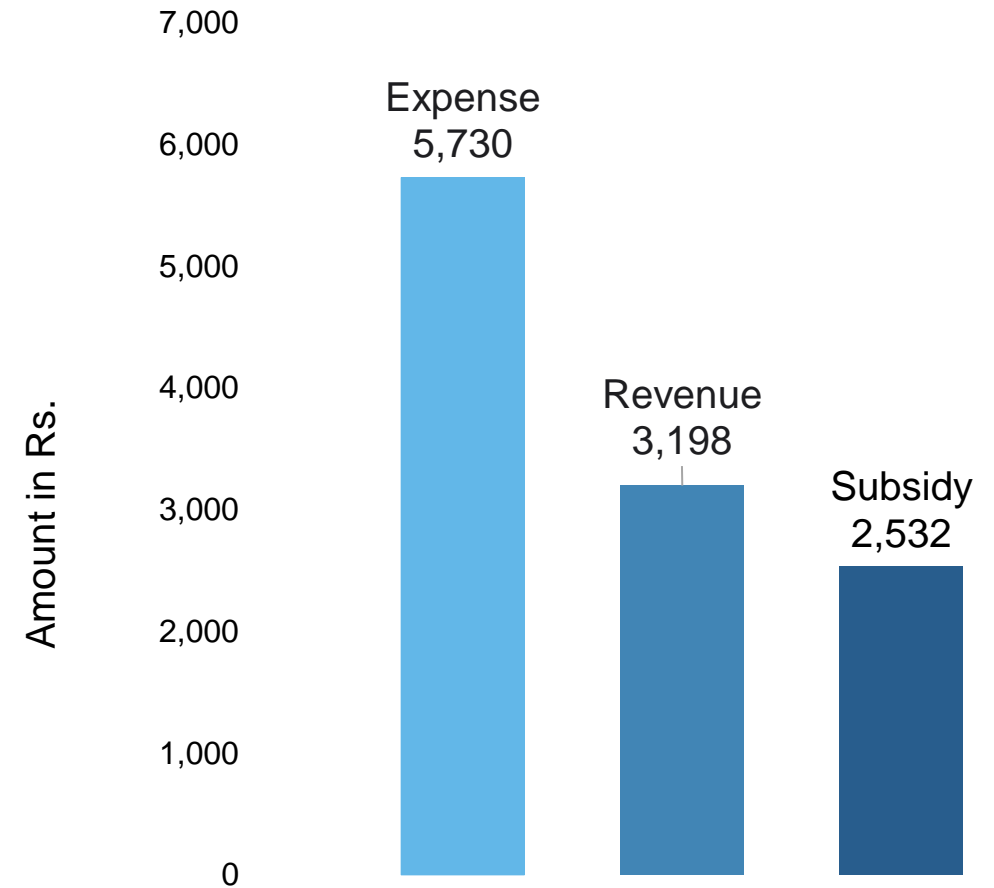


Subsidy per student per month: Rs. 2,532/-

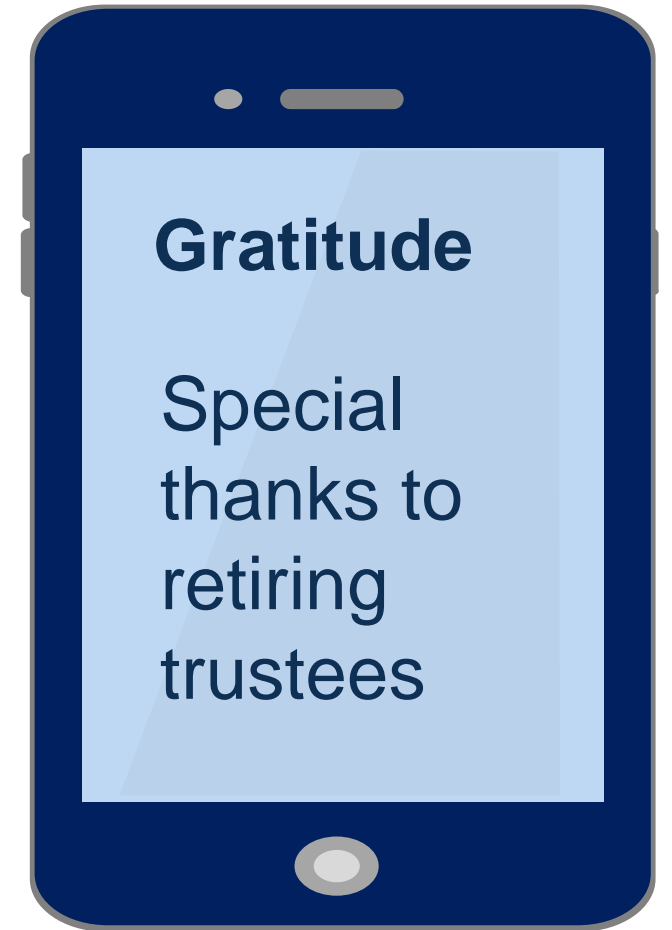
